## CONSEQUENCES

Students who have difficulty following classroom and school rules will have logical consequences based on the undesirable behavior. See below for a few examples:

Behavior	Consequence
Inappropriate behavior in the restroom/hallway	Student will need to be accompanied to the bathroom for future visits.
Classroom disruption	Student will be moved away from classmates to complete work and visit a buddy teacher.
Inappropriate use of materials (chrome books, science materials, math manipulatives)	Student will not be able to use materials and will need to complete paper/pencil activities only until they earn back this privilege.
Disrespectful language to adults or classmates	Student will write an apology letter at home, during recess or during free time.

Additionally, parents will be notified as needed for more serious negative behaviors and/or referred to the behavior specialist. You will be able to access behavior reports through Class Dojo.
