

KEEPING ORGANIZED WITH AGENDA BOOKS

Each child will be given an agenda book at the beginning of the year. It should be brought to all classes each day and brought home each night.

TIPS FOR MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR AGENDA BOOK:

- Each week, choose a night to sit down as a family and write down any upcoming important events.
- On Monday, plan which nights will be used for homework, studying, and extra-curricular activities.
- Write down which fact fluency facts need to be worked on each week.
- Make notes/reminders to bring back books, replenish supplies, and questions to ask your teacher.
- Write down upcoming tests, field trips and important events.

WHY SHOULD I USE MY AGENDA BOOK?

- Using your agenda book will help you manage your time for studying, homework and after-school activities.
- Parents/guardians can use it to communicate with your teachers.
- Your teachers will award prizes and Class Dojo points for students actively using agenda books.

HOMework

Homework helps to strengthen the connection between school and home. Homework is given to reinforce concepts that we have been covering in school.

- Homework will be assigned in Mathematics, Language Arts and Science/Social Studies each week, starting the 2nd week of school. Your child will bring home 3 packets.
- Homework will be handed out on Monday of each week, and due on Friday. There may be some exceptions due to days off, tests, etc. Homework will be accepted on Monday for ½ credit if it is incomplete on Friday.
- Each child will be given a homework folder to bring the homework to and from school.
- Students will be permitted to use HERO lab time each week to work homework.

TESTS

- *Students will have tests in all subject areas. Students will need to study and prepare for tests. Students will be notified at least 3 days before an upcoming unit tests.*
